



Establishing a VFW Auxiliary National Art Scholarship

Establishing a VFW Auxiliary National Patriotic Art scholarship requires a one-time investment and must be paid in one lump sum; it cannot be cumulative.

Scholarships are based on 12 months of accrual. Therefore, VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters must receive the total investment no later than February 1 **prior** to the Program Year that the first (initial) scholarship will be given.

The following indicates the investment required for each National Art scholarship level:

\$2,500		\$62,500
\$2,000		\$50,000
\$1,500		\$37,500
\$1,000		\$25,000
\$750		\$18,750
\$500		\$12,500

Checks establishing or increasing these scholarships should be made payable to VFW Auxiliary and mailed to the address below along with this form. The Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary retains the authority to invest the assets of the fund in such a manner as to perpetuate the annual award.
